



Swim Test Policy

All youth ages 12 and under must take a Safety Swim Test (SST):

Swim the width of the swim area to a designated point and back without assistance or stopping. The swimmer will then tread water for one minute without assistance and exit the pool.

Based on swim test results, the following bands must be worn and designations followed:

GREEN BAND

- Permitted in the deep area of the pool.
- Accompanying adult (age 18 years old & older) must be present on deck for supervision.



RED BAND

- Restricted to shallow area and must be accompanied in the pool by an adult at all times.
- Must remain in a lifejacket AND/OR be within arm's reach of an adult.
- Adults can supervise no more than 2 youth in the pool at a time.
