## WAIMANALO COUNTRY FARMS EXCURSION

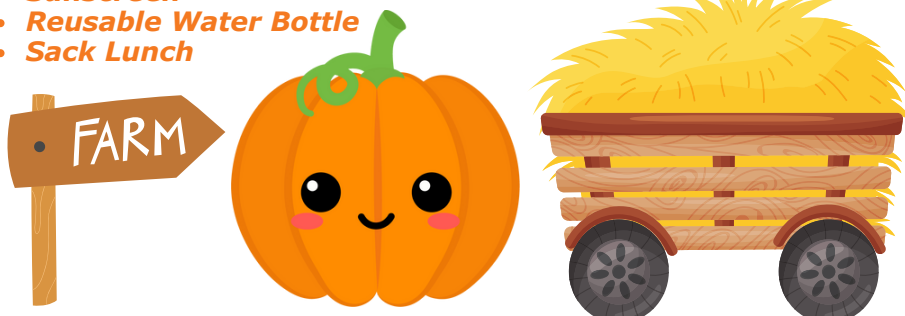
